(DLMS starts purebred sale broadcasts approximately 30 min prior to sale time and the VIEW SALE button will appear at this point when the sale broadcast is started.)

5. During the sale when the lot comes up you are interested in bidding on simply click the Bid button. When your bid has been accepted your bid button will turn RED. If the price increases and you are out bid your bid button will turn back to BLUE to stay as the high bidder you must bid again. 


